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# A Preventable Tragedy: The Kerry Ingredients Workplace Scalding Accident

## Description

### The Incident

#### A Routine Task Gone Wrong

Elver Alicarte, a 38-year-old employee at Kerry Ingredients in Hartlepool, was performing a routine task on an industrial cooking vessel. His job was to re-attach an end cap to the pipework connected to the vessel, which was being cleaned with a very hot solution.

#### The Critical Mistake

Unbeknownst to Mr. Alicarte, a colleague activated a switch, opening the outlet valve. This action released the scorching cleaning fluid down the pipe and over Mr. Alicarte's arm. The outcome was a severe scald injury to his right forearm. The pain and severity of the injury were significant, sidelining him from work for two weeks and temporarily limiting the movement of his arm.

### The Aftermath

#### Legal Consequences for Kerry Ingredients

Following the incident, the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) took legal action against Kerry Ingredients (UK) Ltd. The company was fined £15,000 and ordered to pay £8,950.20 in costs. They were found guilty of breaching section 3(1) of the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999 and regulations 8(1) and 19(3) of the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998.

### Expert Insights

#### HSE Inspector's Perspective

HSE inspector Jonathan Wills commented on the case, emphasizing that Mr. Alicarte's painful injury was both avoidable and preventable. The company should have conducted a thorough risk assessment. Simple control measures could have been implemented to safeguard employees and prevent such accidents. These measures were not in place, leading to Mr. Alicarte's unfortunate injury.
