

Serious Workplace Incident at Wigan Lidl: Employee Hospitalised with Major Injury

Description

A Lidl employee in Wigan has suffered severe injuries following a workplace accident that has prompted an urgent investigation by Greater Manchester Police. The incident, which occurred late Wednesday night, has left the worker with what authorities describe as “life-changing” injuries.

Emergency services were alerted to the situation at the Whitworth Way Lidl store at approximately 9:48 p.m. on April 17, 2024. Responding swiftly, paramedics and specialized teams, including the Hazardous Area Response Team, arrived at the scene. The injured worker, a woman, was quickly transported to the hospital for treatment of a serious leg injury. The severity of her condition has raised significant concern, with medical professionals describing the injury as potentially life-altering.

Greater Manchester Police have since launched a thorough investigation into the incident, aiming to uncover the exact circumstances that led to the tragic event. A police statement confirmed the initiation of this investigation, emphasizing the critical nature of the situation: “At around 10 p.m. on Wednesday, April 17, 2024, Greater Manchester Police were called to a report of a workplace accident involving an individual on Whitworth Way, Wigan. A female sustained life-changing injuries and an investigation has been launched.”

Details about how the woman sustained the leg injury remain undisclosed, leaving the public and concerned parties in suspense. The incident has sparked questions about workplace safety protocols at the Lidl store, with many eagerly awaiting the findings of the ongoing investigation.

A spokesperson for the North West Ambulance Service provided additional details, stating, “We responded to an incident following a call at 9:48 p.m., sending an ambulance, two response vehicles, a doctor, an advanced paramedic, and the Hazardous Area Response Team. A patient was taken to the hospital with a serious leg injury.”

The severity of the injury and the quick response of emergency services underscore the gravity of the situation. The cordon established around the store remained in place until approximately 11:25 p.m. as authorities worked to secure the area and gather evidence.

In addition to the police investigation, Wigan Council has confirmed that it is conducting its own inquiry into the workplace incident. The council’s involvement highlights the seriousness of the situation and the broader implications for workplace safety regulations in the region.

The community is now left waiting for further information as investigations continue. The incident serves as a stark reminder of the potential dangers that can arise in the workplace and the critical importance of maintaining rigorous safety standards.
